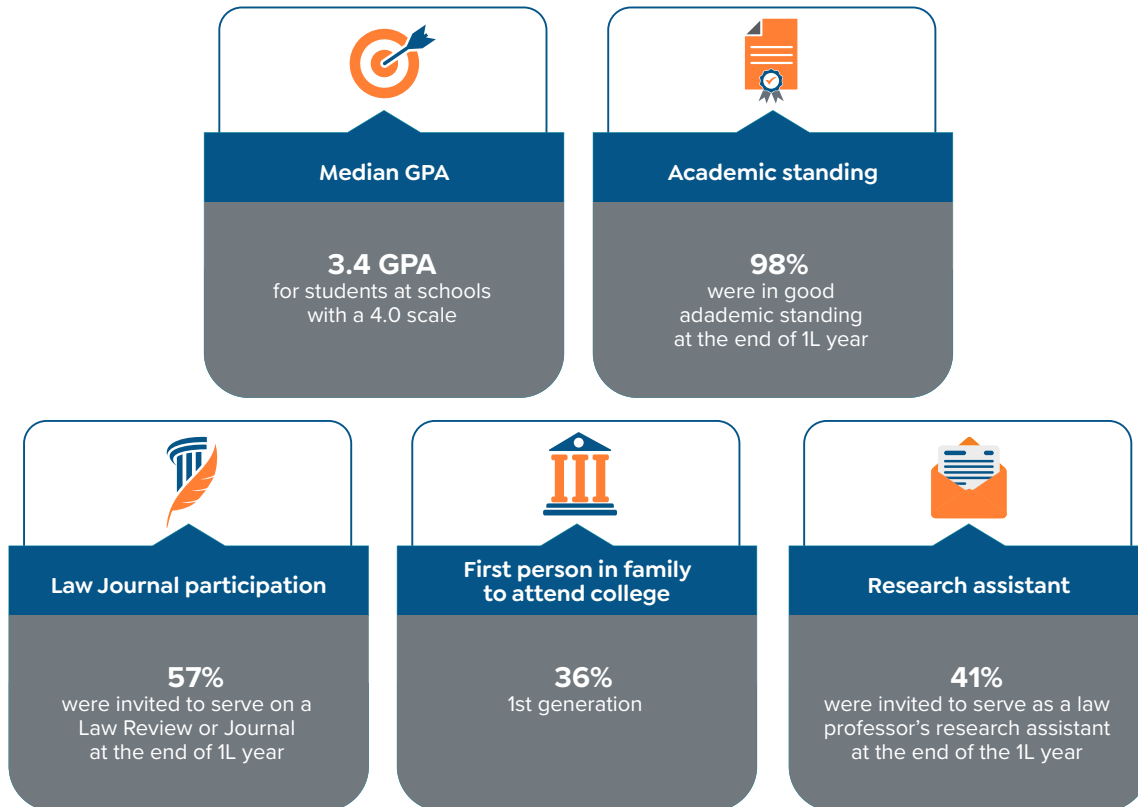

Who oversees the scholarship application/acceptance process?

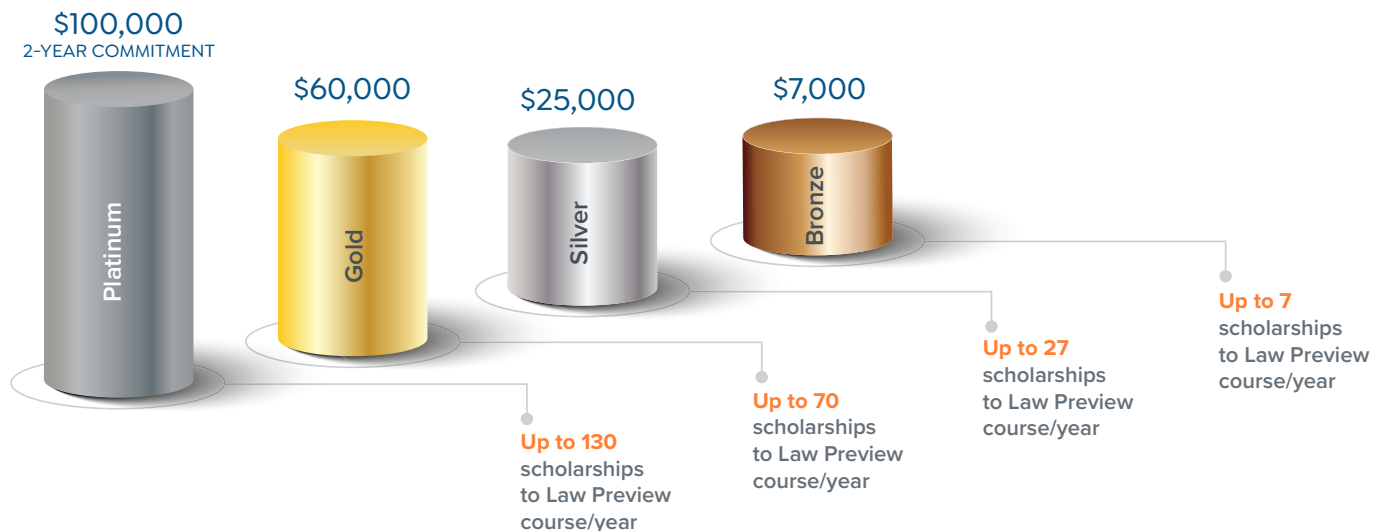
