

The MPRE (Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam) is a two-hour, 60-question multiple choice exam developed by the NCBE (National Conference of Bar Examiners). A passing MPRE score is required for bar admission in all but three U.S. states*. The MPRE is administered three times per year in March, August, and November. Registration for the exam is completed via the NCBE's website. The free, online BARBRI MPRE Review course is available prior to each exam to help you prepare.
